The Pennsylvania Office of Vocational Rehabilitation, or OVR, provides vocational rehabilitation services to help persons with disabilities prepare for, obtain, or maintain employment. OVR provides services to eligible individuals with disabilities, both directly and through a network of approved vendors. Services are provided on an individualized basis. The OVR counselor, during face-to-face interviews, assists customers in selecting their choice of vocational goals, services and service providers. An Individualized Plan for Employment (IPE) is developed, outlining a vocational objective, services, providers and responsibilities. Certain services are subject to a Financial Needs Test (FNT) and may require financial participation by the customer. Counseling and guidance, diagnostic services, assessments, information and referral, job development and placement, and personal services such as readers or sign language interpreters are provided at no cost to the individual. Also, by law OVR customers receiving Social Security benefits for their disability (SSI, SSDI) are exempt from OVR's Financial Needs Test.

Statewide there are 21 District Offices staffed with trained, professional Vocational Rehabilitation Counselors which serve Pennsylvania in all 67 counties. The Hiram G. Andrews Center in Johnstown provides vocational training and comprehensive rehabilitation services to people from across the state. OVR's Bureau of Blindness and Visual Services also provides specialized services to blind and visually impaired individuals. These services are designed to increase an individual's independence and employability. OVR's central administrative offices in Harrisburg provide technical assistance to local district offices in order to improve service delivery.

Office of Vocational Rehabilitation (OVR)

EARLY REACH INITIATIVE:

The Office of Vocational Rehabilitation started Early Reach to increase successful outcomes for youth with disabilities by increasing awareness of OVR services, independent living skills, career planning, and the role of OVR in the transition from school to adult life.

EARLY REACH COORDINATORS:

An Early Reach Coordinator is assigned to each district OVR office in PA to connect earlier with youth with disabilities, their parents, local schools, and other community agencies. Coordinators reach out to youth with disabilities as early as age 14, so that they know more about OVR services and what to expect from vocational rehabilitation services. In addition, Coordinators are knowledgeable about the full array of services available to youth with disabilities.

THE ROLE OF THE EARLY REACH COORDINATOR:

Early Reach Coordinators provide informational presentations and consultation to school personnel, community agencies, youth with disabilities, and families to outline services offered by OVR. Coordinators also provide education and consultation on the benefits of early career planning and the development of independent living skills. Coordinators can assist youth with disabilities in planning and applying for OVR services, and can provide consultation and links to resources that will help youth with disabilities pursue both independence and participation in the workforce.

Mental Health Services:

Mental Health services are targeted for adults who are seriously mentally ill and children/ adolescents who are seriously emotionally disturbed or at-risk of becoming so. Initial access to our services is through our Information and Referral Unit. Staff members at our Mental Health Office are responsible for case managing ongoing services for consumers. The following services are provided by the agency either directly or via contracts with area service providers: Crisis Intervention Services including Telephone Counseling, Mobile Crisis, and Crisis Residential Services; Outpatient Services; Targeted Case Management (Intensive Case Management and Resource Coordination); Psychiatric Rehabilitation Services; Community Treatment Team Services; Facility and Community Based Vocational Programs; Residential Services; Family Support Services; Housing Support Services; Social Rehabilitation Services; Family Based Services; Warmline Services. The agency also offers Disaster Mental Health Services. Under the Student Assistance Program, mental health services are provided to students on site at area elementary, middle and high schools. Short-term inpatient services are provided by area hospitals on either a voluntary or involuntary basis. Service philosophy is consumer oriented (client-centered and strengths-based) with the goal of offering a continuum of recovery based services that allow persons to remain in their community. Services for children and adolescents are offered in accordance with CASSP core principals.

Intellectual Disability Services:

Northampton County Office Developmental Programs, in cooperation with the Commonwealth Office of Developmental Programs coordinates service to county residents of all ages with intellectual disabilities. Developmental Programs services include Residential Programming (Community Homes, Family Living and Supported Living), Adult Developmental Training, Vocational Programming, Community Employment Services, Family Support Services, a Family Driven-Family Support Program, and In-Home Waiver Program. The County subcontracts with service providers. Early Intervention services are for developmentally delayed children birth to age three. Service Coordinators assist consumers and families in accessing these services.

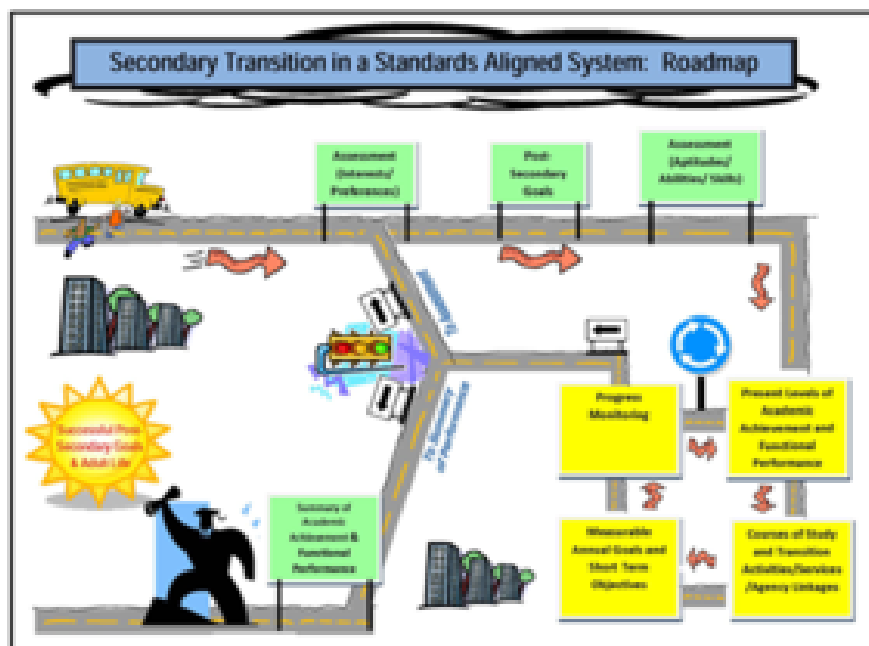

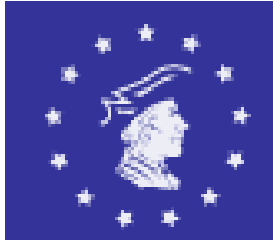
